- 3. CONSIDER and APPOINT members to City Affiliated Organizations;
- 3. DIRECT the City Clerk to notify all affected appointments of this action in writing;
- 4. IF APPLICABLE, DIRECT the City Clerk to post and publish in accordance

with the Maddy Act.
