

RESOLUTION NO. 22-246

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CARSON, CALIFORNIA, REALLOCATING COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT-CORONAVIRUS FUNDS
FROM LOCAL BUSINESS ASSISTANCE TO
HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION SERVICES AND COVID-
RELATED RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATION

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2020, the President of the United States signed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the CARES Act, the City of Carson was awarded \$1,152,051 in supplemental Community Development Block Grant funding specifically to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus health emergency (CDBG-CV); and

WHEREAS, the City has an unexpended balance of \$233,765.69 in CDBG-CV funding;
and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to reallocate this unexpended balance;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, FIND, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following allocations shall be made from the aforementioned unexpended balance of CDBG-CV funds:

Increase:
