As you know, I represent Hardy & Harper, Inc. (“H&H”) regarding the above-referenced public works project for the City of Carson. As discussed and agreed in our meeting on October 27, 2022, the City and H&H have mutually agreed to allow H&H to withdraw its bid for the Annual Overlay Program and Annual Concrete Replacement Program – Main Street (CIP 1393-4/1411-4) (“Carson 3”) without penalty. The parties agree that neither party has any obligations to the other regarding the aforementioned Carson 3 project. The parties further agree that they are now returned to their original positions, as if H&H never submitted a bid for Carson 3.
