Maintenance Agreement, dated July 21, 1953, by and between the County of Los Angeles and the Los Angeles City School District of Los Angeles County, referring to the proposed construction by the said District, at its own expense, of a bridge across Santa Fe Avenue at the location of the Dominguez School, 21250 Santa Fe Avenue, Long Beach, to be called the Dominguez Pedestrian Overpass, which overpass will lie within the right of way for Santa Fe Avenue, and part of the County Primary Highway System, - and whereby the District agrees, at its sole cost and expense, to maintain, repair and renew the entire structure after its completion, in a good and first-class condition for safe and convenient use, and to save harmless the County from all suits or actions brought for or on account of any injury or damage incurred in connection with the construction and maintenance of the said structure and its use by the public.

MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

This Agreement, made and entered into this 21st
day of July, 1953, by and between the COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES,
hereinafter called the COUNTY, and the LOS ANGELES CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY, hereinafter called the DISTRICT.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Dominguez School, located at 21250 Santa Fe
Avenue, Long Beach, California, is in and operated by the DISTRICT, and

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT proposes to construct a bridge at its
own expense across Santa Fe Avenue at said location, to be called the
Dominguez Pedestrian Overpass, hereinafter called the Overpass, and

WHEREAS, the Overpass will be owned by and the property of
the DISTRICT, and

WHEREAS, the Overpass will lie within the right of way for
Santa Fe Avenue, and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe Avenue at the location of the Overpass is
a part of the County Primary Highway System.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefits to the
COUNTY and DISTRICT and of the premises herein contained, it is hereby
agreed as follows:

1. After the completion of the Overpass, the DISTRICT shall,
at its sole cost and expense, maintain the entire structure. The entire
expense of maintaining, repairing, and renewing said Overpass, in a good
and first-class condition for safe and convenient use, shall be borne
by the DISTRICT.

When such work is or caused to be performed by the COUNTY, the DISTRICT agrees to forthwith reimburse the COUNTY upon demand for all expenses incurred in connection therewith.
