RECITALS

- A. City and Contractor entered into that certain Agreement dated May 16, 2018 ("Agreement") whereby Contractor agreed to complete Project No. 1515: Carriage Crest Park Stormwater Capture Facility to assist City to comply with Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) stormwater permit requirements ("Project"), for a contract sum not to exceed \$11,198,500.00. On April 17, 2017, the City Council authorized the expenditure of a 15% construction contingency in an amount not to exceed \$1,679,775.00 to allow for change orders such as the removal and remediation of contaminated soil, substructure conflicts, and other unforeseen construction work that may be required to complete this Project.
- B. The Project has required City and Contractor to approve various change orders identified as Change Orders 1-3 (collectively, "Change Orders 1-3"), due to various factors, including those that concern shoring wall deflection, storm trap installation, additional environmental work, and additional soil removal. The total amount of Change Orders 1-3 is \$1,638,424.87 which, when added to the Contract Sum of \$11,198,500.00, results in an adjusted Contract Sum of \$12,836,924.90. The City and Contractor now desire that the City Council ratify and approve Change Orders 1-3.
- C. Flaws in the design of the Project prepared by the designer, Tetra Tech, were identified to have caused drainage issues that created water ponding in the vaults that housed the valves, actuators, sensors, and other mechanical and electrical equipment. The design flaws have been evaluated with the designer and a design change has been issued to provide additional drains and to adjust surface grading to divert water away from the vaults. The design changes that need to be made to fully commission the Project include grading, replacement of actuators and sensors, new drop inlets for drainage and irrigation, and seeding for the area that is being graded to avoid water intrusion into the vaults ("Corrected Designs").
- D. Due to Change Orders 1-3 totaling \$1,638,424.87, only \$41,350.13 from the \$1,679,775.00 contingency currently remains available from the funds authorized by the City Council.
- E. An additional change order in the amount of \$383,684.05 ("Change Order 4") is needed to allow Contractor to perform additional work to implement the Corrected Designs into the Project. The City and Contractor now desire that the City Council approve Change Order 4.
- F. City Council's ratification and approval of Change Orders 1-3 and approval of Change Order 4 (collectively, "Collective Change Orders") will ratify and approve (i) expansion

of the Scope of Work for the Project; (ii) increase the Contract Sum to \$13,220,608.90; and (iii) require extension of the deadline to complete the Project to April 4, 2024.

TERMS

- 1. Contract Changes. The Agreement is amended as provided herein (new text is identified in *bold italics*, deleted text in strike through):
- A. Article II. (Contract Sum and Payment) of the Agreement is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"II. CONTRACT SUM AND PAYMENT

For performing and completing the work in accordance with the Contract Documents, Owner shall pay Contractor, in full compensation therefore, the contract sum set forth in the Bidding Schedule *and as set forth in the Collective Change Orders*. Said sum shall constitute payment in full for all work performed hereunder, including, without limitation, all labor, materials, equipment, tools and services used or incorporated in the work, supervision, administration, overhead, expenses and any and all other things required, furnished or incurred for completion of the work as specified in the Contract Documents. Owner shall make payments to Contractor on account of the contract sum at the time, in the manner, and upon the conditions specified in the Contract Documents."

B. The first paragraph of Article III. (Contract Documents) of the Agreement is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"III. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

The Contract Documents, which constitute the entire agreement between the Owner and the Contractor, are enumerated as follows: Bid Documents, including the Invitation for Bids, Instructions to Bidders, Bidding Schedule, Bidder's Declaration, Designation of Subcontractors, Bidder's Assurance, and Fair Employment Practices documents; this Agreement; Standard Specifications; Special Provisions; Technical Provisions; Referenced Reports; Drawings; Plans; and all addenda issued prior to and all modifications issued after the execution of this Agreement, *including Exhibit "B," attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. Exhibit "B" represents the work set out in the Collective Change Orders.* A Modification is (1) a written amendment to the Contract signed by both parties, (2) a Change Order, (3) a written interpretation issued by the Architect or (4) a written order for a minor change in the Work issued by the Architect. These form the Contract, and all are as fully a part of the Contract as if attached to this Agreement or repeated herein."

C. Article IV. (Contractor's Basic Obligation) of the Agreement is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"IV. CONTRACTOR'S BASIC OBLIGATION

Contractor promises and agrees, at its own cost and expense, to furnish to the Owner all labor, materials, tools, equipment, services, and incidental and customary work necessary to fully and adequately complete construction of **Project No. 1515** - Carriage Crest Park, and all structures and facilities described in the Contract (hereinafter the "Work"), for a total of *Thirteen Eleven Million Two One Hundred Twenty Ninety Eight Thousand Six Five Hundred Eight DOLLARS and Ninety Zero CENTS (\$13,220,608.90 \$11,198,500.00), as specified in the Contract Proposal Forms submitted by the Contractor in response to the above referenced Invitation for Bids. Such amount shall be subject to adjustment in accordance with the applicable terms of this Contract. All Work shall be subject to, and performed in accordance with the above referenced documents."*

D. Article VI. (Period of Performance) of the Agreement is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"VI. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

Contractor shall perform and complete all Work under this Contract **ON OR BEFORE** *April 4, 2024 and 385 Working Days* beginning seven (7) Calendar Days after the date on which the Letter of Award is sent by the Owner to the Contractor. Moreover, Contractor shall perform its Work in strict accordance with any completion schedule, construction schedule or project milestones developed pursuant to provisions of the Contract, including but not limited to the Project Schedule located in the Specifications.

Contractor agrees that if such Work is not completed within the aforementioned period and/or pursuant to any such completion schedule, construction schedule or project milestones developed pursuant to provisions of the Contract, including but not limited to the Project Schedule located in the Specifications, it is understood, acknowledged and agreed that the Owner will suffer damage. Pursuant to Government Code Section 53069.85, Contractor shall pay to the Owner as fixed and liquidated damages the sum of seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) PER DAY as provided by the applicable provisions of the General Conditions of this Contract."

E. Article XIII. (Performance and Payment Bonds) is hereby added to the Agreement to read in its entirety as follows:

"XIII. PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BONDS

Concurrently with execution of this Agreement, Contractor shall deliver to the City all of the following bonds:

(a) A performance bond securing the faithful performance of this Agreement, in an amount not less than 100% of the total compensation for this Agreement, as stated in Article IV.

(b) A payment bond, securing the payment of all persons furnishing labor and/or materials in connection with the work under this Agreement, in an amount not less than 100% of the total compensation for this Agreement, as stated in Article IV.

The bonds shall each contain the original notarized signature of an authorized officer of the surety and affixed thereto shall be a certified and current copy of his/her power of attorney. The bonds shall be unconditional and remain in force during the entire term of the Agreement until released pursuant to the Contract Documents."

- **2. Continuing Effect of Agreement.** Except as amended by this Amendment, all provisions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect. From and after the date of this Amendment, whenever the term "Agreement" appears in the Agreement, it shall mean the Agreement, as amended by this Amendment to the Agreement.
- 3. Affirmation of Agreement; Warranty Re Absence of Defaults. City and Contractor each ratify and reaffirm each and every one of the respective rights and obligations arising under the Agreement. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, City and Contractor ratify, reaffirm, approve and authorize Change Orders 1-3, and approve and authorize Change Order 4. Each party represents and warrants to the other that there have been no written or oral modifications to the Agreement other than as provided herein. Each party represents and warrants to the other that the Agreement is currently an effective, valid, and binding obligation.

Contractor represents and warrants to City that, as of the date of this Amendment, City is not in default of any material term of the Agreement and that there have been no events that, with the passing of time or the giving of notice, or both, would constitute a material default under the Agreement.

City represents and warrants to Contractor that, as of the date of this Amendment, Contractor is not in default of any material term of the Agreement and that there have been no events that, with the passing of time or the giving of notice, or both, would constitute a material default under the Agreement.

- **4. Adequate Consideration.** The parties hereto irrevocably stipulate and agree that they have each received adequate and independent consideration for the performance of the obligations they have undertaken pursuant to this Amendment.
- **5. Authority.** The persons executing this Amendment on behalf of the parties hereto warrant that (i) such party is duly organized and existing, (ii) they are duly authorized to execute and deliver this Amendment on behalf of said party, (iii) by so executing this Amendment, such party is formally bound to the provisions of this Amendment, and (iv) the entering into this Amendment does not violate any provision of any other agreement to which said party is bound.
- **6. Counterparts.** This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts and each of such counterparts shall for all purposes be deemed to be an original, whether the signatures are originals, electronic, facsimiles or digital. All such counterparts shall together constitute but one and the same Amendment.

Please note the following adjustments/notes:

- 1. Price includes 36" Square DI in place of 30" DI due to availability.
- 2. Deduction for Insurance recovery has been placed within Actuators and UPS Pricing.
- 3. Landscaping items now exclude Planting, Hydroseed and 90-Day maintenance per discussions. These can either be undertaken by Council Staff or performed by OHLA on T&M.
- 4. OHLA has not priced SWPPP obligations under the assumption these works will be undertaken during dry weather. If required, we request these are tracked and paid under Time and Materials.
- 5. OHLA has not priced Quality Verification Testing (compaction, revised survey as-builts etc.) within the above pricing. If required, we request these are tracked and paid under T&M.
- 6. If Permit Costs are required for Traffic Control Plans that these are reimbursed.
- 7. Water is available through the Parks system via a hydrant meter or similar (OHLA to pay regular Hydrant costs). No separate allowance for water trucks was included. If a water truck is required, we request this is tracked and paid under T&M.
- 8. Pricing was developed based on Caltrans Rates through June 2023. As works will be undertaken outside of this period, escalation factors were applied to the Equipment and Labor portions in Number 10 and 11 on pricing sheet.

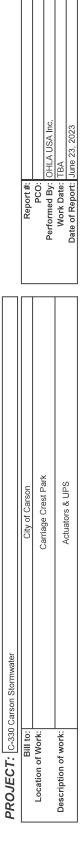

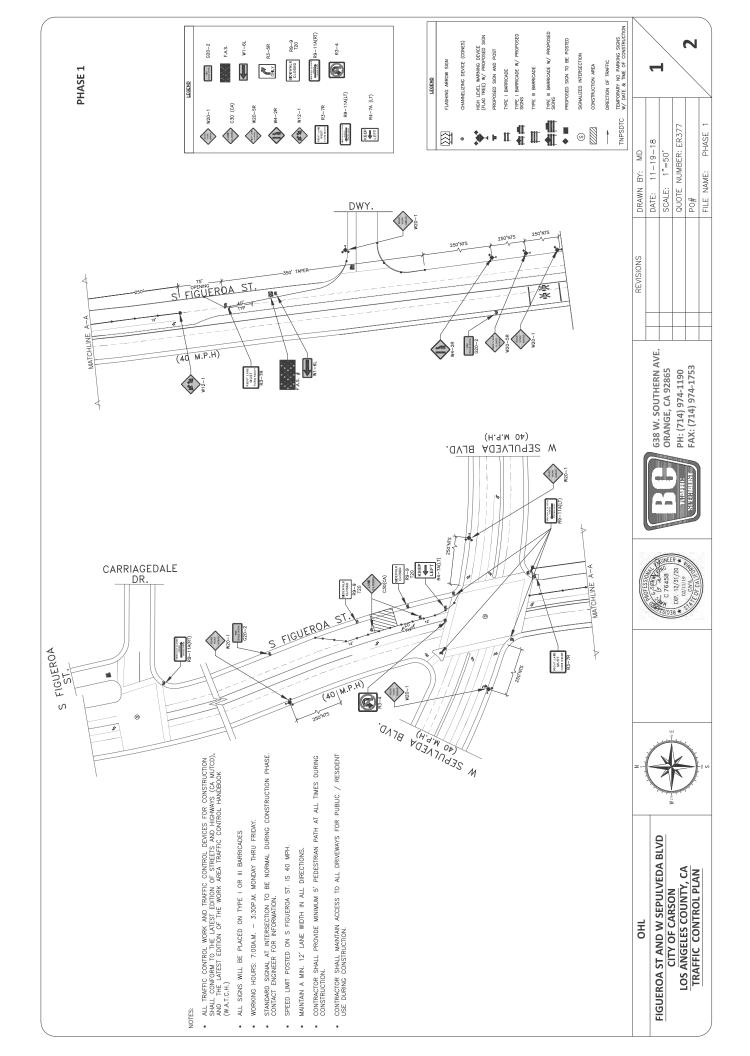

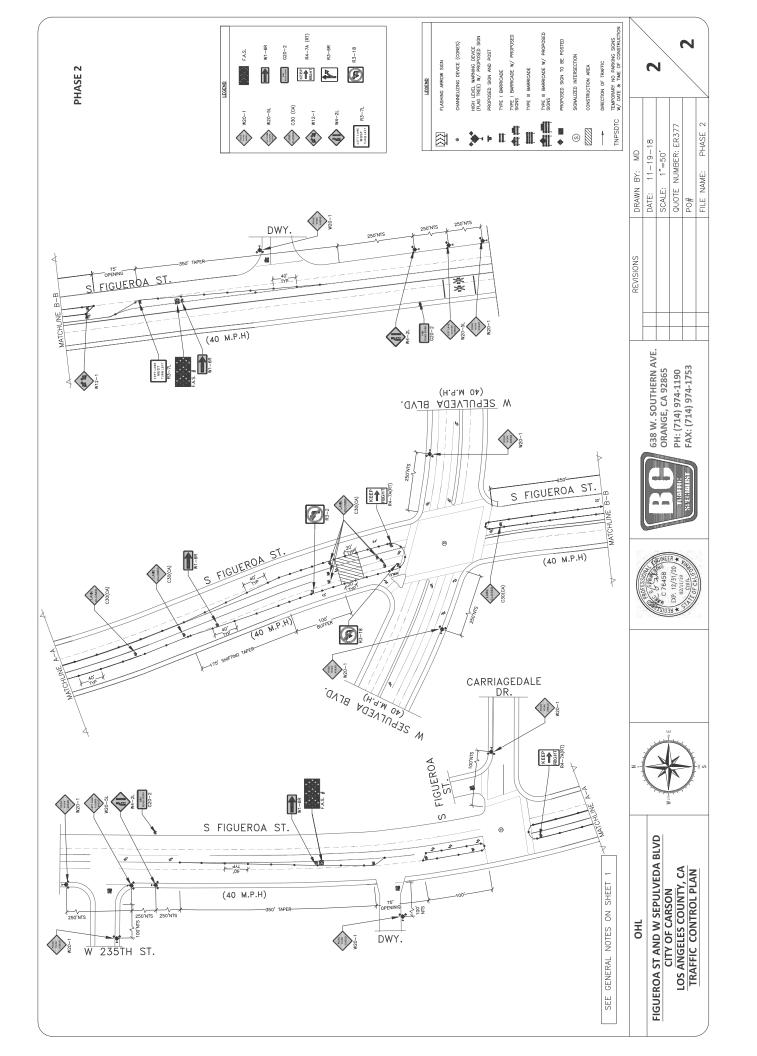

Summary of contemplated work.

This is a summary of the contemplated work scope. The contract drawings take precedence in case of a discrepancy. The grading is focused in the area outside the ballfields to minimize impacts to the ballfields and to avoid removing and reinstalling the outfield fence.

- 1. Adding multiple drain inlets in the area of the vaults outside the ball fields. (See Sheet C-06B)
 - a. The hope is that the proposed pipe alignment results in only minor work inside the ball fields. (Notes 2-4 on Sheet C-06B)
 - b. Grading to create positive drainage to those inlets and have the ground surface elevation lower than the vaults to prevent inflow. (C-06A)
 - c. Slight changes in irrigation/planters/etc. to minimize irrigation onto the vault hatches. (L-01A)
- 2. Replace equipment
 - a. the damaged valve actuators (4 locations)
 - b. damaged valve UPS (1 location)

 - d. Drain fittings on various conduits
 - e. Conduit sealant on various conduit
 - f. Insertion type check valve in storm drain manhole in access road. (See Sht C-06B, Construction Note E)
