The City of Carson deeply cares for its mobile home park residents, and respects the rights of Imperial Avalon Mobile Estates mobile home park ("Park") residents to participate in the public hearing on the administrative appeal of the Carson Planning Commission's Decision on RIR No. 05-20 related to determination of the relocation impact mitigation measures required to be taken by the Park owner in connection with closure of the Park.

Park residents have the following options in regards to submission of public comments prior to the hearing, as stated in the agenda for all items on the agenda:

Residents this option must call in by 5:00 p.m. and provide their full name to the City Clerk via email at cityclerk@carson.ca.us or by calling (310) 952-1720 by 2:00 p.m. on the date of the meeting (Tuesday, July 7, 2020). Residents who call in will be placed on hold until the meeting begins, and the meeting administrator will unmute and call upon residents by name when it is their turn to provide public comment. If your name is called and there is no immediate response, the meeting administrator will move to next public commenter and will not be obligated to return to you. Residents utilizing this option are requested to please follow these instructions very carefully so as to avoid creating unnecessary technical difficulties for City staff and the hearing participants. Zoom participation will be permitted telephonically only; no video calls will be accepted.

The hearing can also be observed by livestream on the City's website (http://ci.carson.ca.us) and on cable television, channels 35 (Spectrum) and 99 (AT&T).

Lastly, based on the Homeowners Association's lawyers' demand, the City is opening the Community Center, Halls A, B, C, to provide an in-person participation option to Park residents. A projector screen and podium will be set up to enable residents to observe the hearing (which will be conducted remotely using Zoom) and provide public comment to the Council in real-time. Attendance will be conditioned upon execution by each attendee of a liability waiver substantially similar to the form attached hereto as Attachment "A-1." To protect public health and safety related to COVID-19, social distancing measures will be strictly enforced, and face masks will be required for all attendees. A contactless

temperature screening will be performed at the entry; anyone with a temperature over 100.3 F will be required to leave the premises. Chairs will be spaced at least 6 feet apart, and no standing or overflow attendance will be permitted. As such, capacity will be limited to 150 persons. Attendance will be allowed on a first-come, first-served basis, and all residents who do not arrive in time to get a chair will be required to leave. Any person who refuses to strictly adhere to these measures will be required to leave.

The City discourages residents from exercising the in-person Community Center participation option due to concerns regarding the spread of COVID-19, especially in light of the recent Guidance on Closure of Sectors in Response to COVID-19 from the California Department of Public Health dated July 1, 2020, available at https://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/CID/DCDC/Pages/COVID-19/Guidance-on-Clo "Guidance"). sure-of-Sectors-in-Response-to-COVID-19.aspx (the Althouah listed the Guidance do not sectors in include gatherings such the aforementioned Community Center option, the Guidance provides that Angeles County is on the State's County Monitoring List, and emphasizes that the risk of transmission of the virus is particularly high in indoor settings due to the release of infectious particles into the air when someone speaks, coughs, sneezes, which is exacerbated in indoor spaces particularly when lacking sinas. appropriate ventilation.

Therefore, for the protection of your own health and the health of others, the City strongly urges you to please seriously consider all other options for public participation first, and to seriously consider the risks involved with the Community Center option, before making any decision to participate in the hearing via the Community Center option. This should be considered a last resort.

I understand that the Program involves the risk of accident and bodily injury, death, or property damage to me, and I agree to assume such risks.

I also understand that an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public space where people are present, including with respect to participation in the Program. I acknowledge that COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. I voluntarily assume all risks of exposure to COVID-19 related to my participation in the Program, and I assume sole responsibility therefor and agree to hold harmless the City of Carson, its officers (elected and appointed), agents and employees (collectively, "City" and individually, "City Party") in connection therewith. I am voluntarily seeking to participate in the Program notwithstanding these risks, and I acknowledge that I must comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws and guidelines, including practicing social distancing and wearing face masks at all times, related to preventing the spread of COVID-19 in connection with my participation in the Program, and further acknowledge that even where I am in full compliance with such laws and guidelines, there is no guarantee that I will not become infected with COVID-19. In furtherance of City's efforts to protect Program participants from being infected with COVID-19, I consent to a contactless temperature screening (showing a temperature below 100.4 F) being performed as a condition of my entrance into the building, and I represent, warrant and attest that:

• I am not experiencing any symptom of illness such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle

pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell;

- I have not traveled internationally or to a highly impacted area within the last 14 days;
- I have not been exposed to someone with a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19 within the last 14 days;
- I have not been previously diagnosed with COVID-19 and not yet cleared as non-contagious by applicable state or local public health authorities; and
- I have been adhering to all applicable federal (including CDC), state and local laws and guidelines related to limiting exposure to COVID-19 for the last 14 days.

In consideration for my participation in the Program, I hereby waive, release and discharge the City and each City Party from and against any and all claims or liabilities to me or any other person, including but not limited to claims or liabilities for bodily injury, illness, death, or property damage, arising from or related in any way to my participation in the Program, including the negligence of the City or any other participants in the Program, and I agree to waive my rights to make any such claims through any action or proceeding against the City. However, I understand that this paragraph is not intended to release any party from any act or omission of "gross negligence."

In giving the foregoing release and waiver, I expressly waive any and all rights conferred upon me by the provisions of California Civil Code Section 1542, which I understand reads as follows:

"A general release does not extend to claims that the creditor or releasing party does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of executing the release and that, if known by him or her, would have materially affected his or her settlement with the debtor or released party."

This waiver shall be effective as a bar to any and all actions, fees, damages, losses, claims, liabilities and demands of whatsoever character, nature and kind, that are known or unknown, or suspected or unsuspected, that may arise from or relate in any way to my participation in the Program.

To the full extent permitted by law, I agree to hold and save the City and each City Party harmless from any and all actions, claims, proceedings, damages to persons or property, losses, costs, fees, expenses, forfeitures, penalties, obligations, errors, omissions or liabilities, whether actual or threatened, that may be asserted or claimed by any person, firm or entity ("Claims") arising out of or in connection with my participation in the Program, and to defend and indemnify the City and each City Party from and against all Claims arising from my negligence or intentional misconduct in connection with my participation in the Program. This obligation shall be binding on my heirs, successors and assigns and shall not

expire.

I hereby grant the City the right to photograph or video-record me during or in connection with the Program, and to use my photographed or video-recorded likeness, and any image, silhouette, or reproduction of me or my voice or appearance taken during or in connection with the Program ("Likeness") for any purpose, including creation or production of materials in any form for such purpose, with no claim of entitlement to any license fee or royalty of any kind from the City.
