RESOLUTION NO. 22-120

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING JUNETEENTH AS AN ANNUAL CITY OF CARSON RECOGNIZED HOLIDAY BEGINNING IN 2022 (CITY COUNCIL)

WHEREAS, in 1863, President Abraham Lincoln issued the Emancipation Proclamation declaring all slaves free. However, this freedom was not made known to many enslaved African Americans until two years after its passage. Juneteenth recognizes that on June 19, 1865, the last enslaved people in Galveston, Texas were informed that slavery had been abolished; and

WHEREAS, when the former slaves heard of this news, they began to celebrate with prayer, feasting, song, and dance. The following year, on June 19, the first official Juneteenth celebrations took place in Texas. Within a few years, African Americans in other states were celebrating the day, making it an annual tradition; and

WHEREAS, the Carson City Council believes that Juneteenth should be recognized as an official holiday in the City of Carson and the State of California, as it was recognized as an official holiday in the state of Texas in 1980, and by the federal government in 2021 (establishing the holiday as taking place on the date of June 19th of each year); and

WHEREAS, Carson Municipal Code Section 2402 allows the City Council to establish City holidays by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of Carson, California desire to recognize the importance and value of June 19, 1865 events by establishing Juneteenth as an officially recognized holiday in the City of Carson.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY FINDS, DETERMINES AND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct.
- **Section 2.** Juneteenth, June 19th, is declared and recognized as an official City of Carson annual holiday beginning in the calendar year of 2022. For the 2022 calendar year, because June 19th falls on a Sunday, the City will observe the holiday on Monday, June 20th.
- **Section 3.** City employees shall receive a paid holiday annually for Juneteenth, consistent with their salary/ benefits resolution or bargaining unit's applicable Memorandum of Understanding, following the completion of any necessary meet and confer process between the City and the respective employee organizations in accordance with the Meyers-Milias Brown Act ("MMBA").

Section 4.	This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
