

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON  
REGARDING THE CITY'S RESIDENTIAL REFUSE COLLECTION CHARGES  
AND INCREASES TO SUCH CITY REFUSE CHARGES**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City Council, ("Council") of the City of Carson, ("City") will hold a public hearing to consider a request by Waste Management to implement a rate increase of approximately 6.29% for its residential refuse collection services within the City. Said public hearing will be held at a regular meeting of the City Council as follows:

**DATE:** Tuesday, August 2, 2016  
**TIME:** 6:00 p.m.  
**PLACE:** Council Chambers, City Hall  
701 East Carson Street  
Carson, California 90745

The residential solid waste disposal services in the City are performed by Waste Management and the charges are billed with your property taxes on the Los Angeles County Tax Roll to residential property owners within the City ("Tax Bill") as the "City Refuse Fee".

Unless the City Council receives protests as described below from a majority of residential property owners, the maximum amounts of City Refuse Fees chargeable on your Tax Bill will increase commencing July 1, 2016, as follows:

| <b>Senior Residential</b><br>(62 years and subject to certain qualifications)  | \$9.98                              | \$10.61                          | \$119.76                           | \$127.32                        | 6.29%  |

If implemented by the Council following the August 2, 2016 hearing, these increases will go into effect retroactively on July 1, 2016. The proposed rates are based upon the increase in the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor and Statistics, Consumer Price Index, All Urban Consumers, Los Angeles-Anaheim-Riverside, reflecting among other things, escalating costs of labor, electricity, supplies, equipment and gasoline. In addition, the proposed increases are based upon the rise in collection and disposal fees due to operational cost increases and regulatory requirements.

Pursuant to the State of California Constitution Article XIII D, record owners of real property subject to the City Refuse Fees who wish to protest the proposed rate increases can mail or deliver a written protest to the City Clerk at the address below, or attend the public hearing on the increase to submit their written protest at the hearing. Only one written protest per residential parcel in the City's service area will be counted. Protests to the proposed



residential City Refuse Fee increase must be submitted in writing. Written protests must be received by 4 pm on August 2, 2016, in the City Clerk's Office or prior to the close of the public hearing on August 2, 2016, in the City Council Chambers. Any written protests received following the close of the public hearing will not be counted.

All written protests must (at a minimum) include the following information to be counted: a) address or identify the affected property by Assessor's Parcel Number (APN); b) identify the name of the person/ratepayer signing the protest and their interest in the subject property (e.g., owner or renter), c) present an original signature of the protester, and d) a clear statement protesting the proposed City Refuse Fees pursuant to this notice. Written protests by electronic mail (e-mail) will not be accepted. If written protests against the proposed residential City Refuse Fee increase are presented by a majority of the affected property owners of the affected parcels, the City will not approve the proposed rate schedule and such City Refuse Fees will remain at their current levels.


