Dear Customer:

As Shell performs work in the Carousel Tract, California Water Service will be moving and replacing water mains in the area. Our crews will install about 5,500 feet of new 8-inch water main beginning **June 19th, 2017** weather permitting. This water main replacement project will improve fire flow and water supply reliability in your area.

Installation for the final phase will take place:

- On the 24400 to the 24700 blocks of Marbella Ave.
- On Neptune Avenue, from E. 244th Street to E. 248th Street.
- On Ravenna Avenue, from E. 244th Street to E. 247th Street.
- On Panama Avenue, from E. 244th Street to E. 247th Street.
- On the 300 block of E. 244th Street.

The work will be performed Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. During this time, we will also move meter boxes and fire hydrants from customers' front yards to the sidewalk. During construction, minor delays are possible; however, we will make every effort to minimize any disruption and inconvenience to you.

Construction is expected to take approximately three months, during which we will install the new main and services, and must flush the water lines prior to taking water quality samples. Please be assured that we are committed to conservation and will flush only as long as necessary to fulfill water quality requirements. After test results are returned, we will tie individual water service connections to the new main.

There will be intermittent interruptions when we tie customer services to the new water main and put the main into service; however, we will notify you 48 hours prior to any planned interruptions, which are normally scheduled between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Please be aware that temporary asphalt will be applied until permanent paving is completed approximately 30 days after project completion. This time delay is necessary to allow the trench to become fully compacted, so the road surface is smooth after permanent paving is completed.
