
EZ Transit Pass



The EZ transit pass is a monthly pass good for local travel on 23 different public transit carriers throughout the Greater Los Angeles region.

All EZ transit passes are sold on plastic TAP cards loaded with an electronic EZ transit pass. You can tap your card on any system that accepts TAP. Simply have your EZ transit pass fare loaded onto your card and remember to tap before boarding.

To apply by mail, submit the <u>senior (http://media.metro.net/riding/tap_sr_app.pdf)</u> / <u>disabled (http://media.metro.net/riding/tap_reduced_lactoa_disabled_application.pdf)</u> application with the required documentation.
