## **RESOLUTION NO. 17-158**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 7, 2017, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Carson, California, on Tuesday, November 7, 2017, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the laws of the State of California relating to general law cities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Carson, City Clerk/Elections Official canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to the City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit A;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the precincts except vote by mail voter ballots was 2857. That the whole number of vote by mail and provisional voter ballots cast in the City was 5288, making a total of 8145 ballots cast in the City.

SECTION 2. That the measure voted upon at the election is as follows:

## MEASURE C

To maintain and improve Carson services, such as 911 emergency, Sheriff protection,	YES
senior/youth/anti-gang programs; repair streets; improve air/environmental quality, reduce hazardous waste; shall an ordinance be adopted imposing tax of 1/4th of 1% of gross receipts of operators of facilities blending, mixing, processing, or refining petroleum or petroleum products and/or storing petroleum products, to provide approximately \$24,000,000 annually until ended by voters, requiring regular compliance audits, with funds used in Carson?	NO

SECTION 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City for and against Measure C are attached as Exhibit A.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on Measure C, to establish an oil industry business license tax, did vote in favor of it, and that Measure C was carried, and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) The measure voted upon; (3) The number of votes given at each precinct for and against the measure; and (4) The total number of votes given for and against the measure.

SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
