WHEREAS, the most current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and its subsequent Amendment No. 1 expired between the City and CPSA expired on December 31, 2016;

WHEREAS, the City labor relations representatives and CPSA labor representatives successfully met and conferred to negotiate a successor MOU between the parties pursuant to both the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act (MMBA) (Government Code Sections 3500-3511) and the City's Employer-Employee Relation Resolution No. 85-107, and jointly prepared and executed a Tentative Agreement For A Successor MOU (deal points) between the City and CPSA for the period January 1, 2017 through and including June 30, 2020, which was accepted, approved, and adopted by the City of Carson City Council on June 19, 2018;

WHEREAS, the CPSA labor representatives thereafter proposed to amend the Tentative Agreement For A Successor MOU to include a fifth (5) year on the contract term of the proposed successor MOU in exchange for an additional 1% COLA in year 3, fixed 3% COLAs in years 3 and 4, and a 3% COLA in year 5, which was accepted by the City labor representatives;

WHEREAS, MMBA Section 3505.1 provides that: "If a tentative agreement is reached by the authorized representatives of the public agency and a recognized employee organization, the governing body shall vote to accept or reject the tentative agreement within 30 days of the date it is first considered at a duly noticed public meeting. If the governing body adopts the tentative agreement, the parties shall jointly prepare a written memorandum of understanding...;" and

WHEREAS, the City labor relations representatives and CPSA labor representatives have jointly prepared and executed, and CPSA members have ratified, an Amended & Restated Tentative Agreement For A Successor MOU (deal points) between the City and CPSA for the period January 1, 2017 through and including June 30, 2021, and have agreed to prepare and execute a final successor MOU between the City and CPSA for the same period.
