

RESOLUTION NO. 18-052

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-19
FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must adopt a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1 by resolution, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City, will receive and estimated \$1,555,555.00 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2018-19 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the second year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1 ; and

WHEREAS, the City has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the City used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate Albertoni Street, an east/west main collector across the City this year, and few more of similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2016 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in an "at-risk/poor" condition and this revenue will help us increase the

overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a "good" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of Carson, State of California, as follows:


1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The fiscal year 2018-19 list of projects planned to be funded with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues include:

Project Description: Albertoni Street from Figueroa Street to Avalon Boulevard is an east/west main collector located at the northern section of the City S/O 91FWY. The estimated useful life is 20 years, and the anticipated year of construction is 2019.

3. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and shall keep a copy of this resolution attached to the FY 2018-19 budget on file, and effective as of May 1, 2018, the same shall be in force and effect.




