CLASS DESCPRIPTION:

Job Summary:

Under elose general supervision to perform a variety of routine and repetitive manual or recreational duties on a seasonal basis and to perform related duties as required.

EXAMPLES OF Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

(These functions are representative and may not be present in all positions in the class. Management reserves the right to add, modify, change or rescind related duties and work assignments.)

-Issues and collects playground equipment-at a recreation center; prepares equipment; assist-in-cleaning play areas and facilities; supervise games for various age groups; assistsin-officiating sports activities; issues, checks, and files personal effects for patrons atcommunity pools; assist-in-cleaning-locker room;, bath house, and swimming pool-area; enforces established rules and regulations governing safe use of city facilities.

- 1. Officiate and/or score keep clinic division T-Ball, flag football, soccer and basketball games.
- 2. Prepare baseball, soccer, football fields, and basketball gyms for youth and adult sports games.
- 3. Assist with setup and breakdown of park programs and citywide events.
- 4. Assist with general cleaning at city facilities and grounds.
- 5. Assist with basic office support such as organizing, scanning, copying, filing, etc.
- 6. Assist with Customer surveys for park programs and citywide events.
- 7. Parking lot attendant for programs and citywide events
- 8. Patrol park grounds and facilities and inform of park rules and city municipal codes
- 9. Notify immediate Supervisor of any hazards or safety concerns

MINIMUM OUALIFICATIONS:

Education and/or Experience:

Completion of formal education sufficient to assure the ability to read and write at the level required for successful job performance. Applicant must be 18 years old to apply.

WORKING CONDITIONS:
