## PROJECT SCOPE AND SPECIFICATIONS

## Consultant will perform the following Services:

A. Remove and dispose of 4200 linear feet (LF) of red curb paint (containing lead) from concrete curbing located along Carson Street from S. Figueroa St. to the 405 Freeway in a manner that complies with all applicable laws and regulations, including those related to hazardous materials and lead abatement. Provide all labor, materials, equipment and supplies necessary to perform such removal and disposal.
B. The removal of the lead-containing paint will be performed by either chemical stripping or grinding methods.
C. Contractor shall provide all labor, materials and equipment to perform the scope of work.
D. Completely contain water used for dust control and from debris generated within specified work areas, during the removal process. Water shall be properly disposed of.
E. Comply with all storm water pollution control per Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) requirements, including but not limited to best management practices (BPs) within the specified work areas.
F. Provide all required notifications to all applicable government agencies.
G. Work will be performed during business hours Monday-Friday, 9:00am to 3:00 pm for arterial streets and 7:00am to 3:00 pm for local/residential streets, unless otherwise stated by the City of Carson.
H. Contractor shall be responsible for arranging and coordinating the disposal of materials generated by the removal of red curb paint containing lead to an appropriate disposal facility and paying any associated fees.
I. In the event that lane closure is necessary to perform the scope of work, contractor shall submit a traffic control plan to the city for review and approval.
J. Contractor shall be responsible for transporting all removed materials to an appropriate facility.
K. Contractor shall obtain a, no fee, encroachment permit with the city for this scope of work.
L. Pedestrian and/or vehicular access shall be allowed at all times, unless approved otherwise by the city engineer.
M. Contractor shall delineate and/or otherwise separate the work area from all nonessential and/or non-consultant personnel and the general public.
N. Consultant will keep the City apprised of the status of performance by delivering daily reports of project status during performance of services and a report at completion of work.
