

## **RESOLUTION NO. 19-059**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City will receive to an estimated \$1,552,527.00 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2019-20 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the third year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the City used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate 223<sup>rd</sup> Street, an east/west main arterial running across the City this year, and multiple more similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in an "at-risk/poor" condition and this revenue will help us increase the

RESOLUTION NO. 19-059 Page 1 of 3 overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a "good" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

**NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND** by the City Council of the City of Carson, State of California, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

2. The following list of proposed projects will be funded in part or solely with fiscal year 2019-20 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

A. Project Description: 223<sup>rd</sup> Street from Wilmington Avenue to the east City limit is an east/west main arterial located at the southern section of the City. The project work will be in that location and will include pavement rehabilitation and construction of new or replacement of existing concrete improvements. The estimated useful life is 20 years, and the anticipated start of construction is in June 2020 and date of completion is in September 2020.

3. The following previously proposed and adopted projects may utilize fiscal year 2019-20 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

A. Albertoni Street Rehabilitation project, originally listed in FY 2018/19. This is an east/west main arterial road located at the northern section of the City. Work includes pavement rehabilitation and construction of new or replacement of existing concrete improvements. The estimated useful life is 20 years, the anticipated start of construction is July 2019 and date of completion is September 2019. The Albertoni project may need to use FY 2019/20 RMRA funds.

4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions. The City Clerk shall keep a copy of this resolution attached to the FY 2019-20 budget on file.

5. This Resolution is effective on the date of its adoption.
