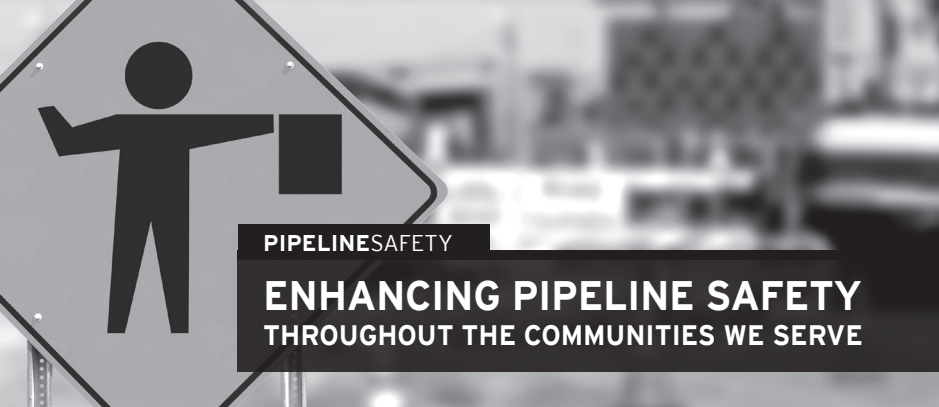


## Wilmington Closure Outreach Plan – Carson

## CARSON - Wilmington Avenue - REPLACEMENT

- **CONSTRUCTION AREA:** Wilmington Ave. between 223<sup>rd</sup> St. & Watson Center Rd.
- **ESTIMATED START DATE:** October 28, 2019
- **Duration:** approximately 3-4 months (weather and other factors permitting).
- **STREET CLOSURES:** Wilmington Avenues full lane closures for north and southbound traffic on Wilmington Avenue between 223<sup>rd</sup> Street and Watson Center Road. No left turn for westbound traffic on 223<sup>rd</sup> Street at Wilmington Avenue and no right turn for eastbound traffic on 223<sup>rd</sup> Street at Wilmington Avenue.

Dear Neighbor,

SoCalGas® will be in your neighborhood soon to work on a section of our natural gas pipelines. We are dedicated to maintaining the safety and integrity of our natural gas system. We routinely perform various maintenance and safety tasks, including patrolling, inspecting, testing, repairing and replacing pipelines. Enhancing our system ensures we can continue to reliably provide the natural gas service that our customers count on. Natural gas is critical to providing an affordable and reliable energy source for heating water and cooking to homes and businesses.

Below is important information regarding the work that will take place in the City of Carson.

<b>Estimated start date:</b>	October 28, 2019
<b>Duration of work:</b>	Approximately 2 – 3 months to complete (permitting weather and other factors)
<b>Work hours:</b>	Monday through Sunday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.
<b>Work area:</b>	Construction will take place on Wilmington Avenue south 223 <sup>rd</sup> Street
<b>Traffic Impacts:</b>	Wilmington Avenue full lane closures for north and southbound traffic on Wilmington Avenue between 223rd Street and Watson Center Road. No left turn for westbound traffic on 223rd Street at Wilmington Avenue and no right turn for eastbound traffic on 223rd Street at Wilmington Avenue.

## What to expect

- SoCalGas and its contractors' trucks and heavy equipment will be in the area
- Excavation and pipeline installation work will be conducted in a series of sections
- Construction and/or operational noise from equipment and personnel
- Motorists are asked to follow all traffic signs and markers for their safety and the safety of others

The pipeline replacement work involves installing new pipeline parallel to the path of the existing pipeline. Next, the existing pipeline is taken out of service and all natural gas is safely removed from it. The new pipeline section is then connected to the system and brought into service.

## You may notice an odor of natural gas

To perform this work safely, the operation may require a controlled release of natural gas. We encourage anyone who has concerns to call us at **1-800-427-2200**. We are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation for this inconvenience. Your natural gas service should continue without interruption. If that changes, a SoCalGas representative will notify you.
