

RESOLUTION NO. 20-174

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CARSON, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE 2019-2020
ANNUAL ACTION PLAN BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE
\$679,161.00 IN A SECOND ALLOCATION OF COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT-CORONAVIRUS
(CDBG-CV) FUNDS

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the City Council declared a local state of emergency in response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2020, the United States Congress passed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, and said Act was signed by the President on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the CARES Act included \$2 billion in supplemental funding for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) entitlement communities to enable them to prevent, prepare for and respond to the effects of the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has provided for expedited review of CDBG-CV funding allocations if they are submitted as Substantial Amendments to local governments' 2019-2020 Annual Action Plans; and

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2020, the City Council approved a Substantial Amendment to the 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan, appropriating \$472,890.00 in CDBG-CV funding; and

WHEREAS, HUD has informed the City of Carson that it will receive \$679,161.00 in a subsequent allocation of CDBG-CV funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, FIND, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approval of the submission of a Substantial Amendment to the 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for the purpose of receiving \$679.161.00 in CDBG-CV funding is hereby granted .

Section 2. The following amendments shall be made to the City's budget:
