A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, IN SUPPORT SB 765 (STERN) – SETBACK FLEXIBILITY FOR ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS

WHEREAS, State law provides for the creation of accessory dwelling units by local ordinance, or, if a local agency has not adopted an ordinance, by ministerial approval, in accordance with specified standards and conditions; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 65852.2 currently prohibits a local agency's accessory dwelling unit ordinance from imposing a setback requirement of more than 4 feet from the side and rear lot lines for an accessory dwelling unit that is not converted from an existing structure or a new structure constructed in the same location and to the same dimensions as an existing structure; and

WHEREAS, the 4 feet setback requirement has taken away a local agency's authority to do proper planning to achieve an optimal, safe, and structurally balanced ADU location and fails to take into consideration topographical or geographical issues or land use concerns that may be unique to a land parcel or local agency; and

WHEREAS, SB 765 would remove the current one-size-fits-all approach and give local agencies the option to return to setback regulations they had established prior to the State law mandating the 4-foot setback; and

WHEREAS, to ensure local agencies do not use setbacks as a method to prohibit ADUs, SB 765 would authorize an accessory dwelling unit applicant to submit a request to the local agency for an alternative rear and side yard setback requirement if the local agency's setback requirements make the building of the accessory dwelling unit infeasible; and

WHEREAS, Carson City Council is committed to crafting regulations that best reflect the needs and particularities of its local communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby expresses its support for SB 765 and its effort to restore a local agency's authority to establish setback regulations for accessory dwelling units.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
