CONSIDER ADOPTING RESOLUTION NO. 21-082 APPROVING THE CITY OF CARSON'S APPLICATION FOR PROPOSITION 68 STATEWIDE PARK DEVELOPMENT AND COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS (CITY COUNCIL)

I. <u>SUMMARY</u>

Staff requests that the City Council approve Resolution No. 21-082 (Exhibit No. 1) authorizing submission of the City's grant application for a Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program grant to renovate and enhance several areas with Foisia Park and Carriage Crest Park. Because of an oversight, previous Resolution No. 20 -160 left blank the person who would negotiate and sign all documents. The Resolution before the City Council provides that required information in Section 4 as the City Manager or their designee.

IV. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

On Tuesday, November 4, 2021, City Council approved on consent Resolution No. 20-160 authorizing submission of the City's grant application for a Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization grant to renovate and enhance several areas within Foisia Park and Carriage Crest Park.

On Wednesday, June 9, 2021, the City received a letter from the California Department of Parks and Recreation - Office of Grants and Local Services requesting additional information for Foisia Park Renovation grant application. On the original resolution (No. 20 -160) the "designated position" was not filled in to delegate authority to conduct all negotiations and sign and submit documents which would be necessary for the completion of the grant scope. Resolution No. 21-082 corrects that omission and will be submitted as a revised document to the grant application. The revised document is due within 30 days from date of received letter.
