SUBJECT:

SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE NO. 24-2406, "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, ADDING SECTION 63120.1 (CONTRACTORS) TO PART 5 (BUSINESSES, PROFESSIONS, TRADES AND OCCUPATIONS REQUIRING A PERMIT) OF CHAPTER 3 (BUSINESS, PROFESSIONS AND TRADES) OF ARTICLE VI (TAXES AND LICENSES) OF THE CARSON MUNICIPAL CODE TO REQUIRE CONTRACTORS APPLYING FOR PERMITS FOR CERTAIN LARGE PROJECTS TO DISCLOSE LABOR VIOLATIONS" (CITY COUNCIL)

I. SUMMARY

On March 19, 2024, under Item No. 22 of the City Council Agenda, the City Council voted 5 -0 to introduce Ordinance No. 24-2406. This item transmits a request for City Council to conduct a Second Reading and adopt Ordinance No. 24-2406.

II. RECOMMENDATION

TAKE the following action:

1. CONDUCT a Second Reading by title only and with full reading waived, and ADOPT, Ordinance No. Ordinance 24-2406, entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS TO REQUIRE CONTRACTORS WORKING IN THE CITY TO DISCLOSE LABOR LAW VIOLATIONS WITHIN A CERTAIN TIME FRAME"

At the March 19, 2024, Council Meeting, the City of Carson introduced Ordinance No. 24-2406, adding regulations to require contractors working in the City to disclose labor law violations within a certain time frame. The City Council voted 5-0 to introduce Ordinance No. 24-2406 for first reading.
