CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION NO. 17-031 AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF ADMINISTERING AGENCY-STATE MASTER AGREEMENT NO. 07-5403F15 FOR FEDERAL-AID PROJECTS (CITY COUNCIL)

I. <u>SUMMARY</u>

The City of Carson routinely applies for federal and state grants through the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for certain capital improvement projects. The funding reimbursement process is in accordance with the current city and state Administering Agency-State Master Agreement No. 07-5403. Recent changes in federal and state funding legislation require revisions to this agreement and adoption of a resolution by the City Council authorizing the execution of a new Master Agreement (Exhibit No. 1).

Administering Agency-State Master Agreement No. 07-5403F15 reflects the recent federal and state funding legislation changes and must be executed by the city and state prior to the city receiving further federal funds (Exhibit No. 2).

II. <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

WAIVE further reading and ADOPT Resolution No. 17-031, "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE ADMINISTERING AGENCY-STATE MASTER AGREEMENT NO. 07 -5403F15 FOR FEDERAL-AID PROJECTS."

III. ALTERNATIVES

DO NOT ADOPT Resolution No. 17-031. However, if the city does not execute the Master Agreement, it would not be eligible to receive federal and state funds for federally funded projects.

IV. BACKGROUND

The Congress of the United States and the Legislature of the State of California have enacted legislation by which certain federal-aid funds may be made available to the local Administering Agencies for use on local transportation related projects. The Administering Agency and the state are required to enter into an agreement to establish terms and conditions applicable to the Administering Agency prior to receiving federal funds for a designated project facility or the subsequent operation and maintenance of that completed facility.

Carson has been administering federally-funded projects since 1997 using previous versions of the Master Agreement between the City of Carson and the State of California. Recent changes to the funding programs and eligibility requirements of local agencies for receiving federal funds resulted in revisions to the current Master Agreement. The updated Administering Agency-State Master Agreement No. 07-5403F15 reflects the latest changes and is required to be executed by the city and state.

Execution of the Administering Agency-State Master Agreement No. 07-5403F15, followed by a project specific supplemental agreement, will allow the city to receive federal and state reimbursements for future federally funded projects.
