## **IV. BACKGROUND**

Pursuant to Carson Municipal Code (CMC) § 2357, “Duties of the City Clerk”, states in part, “In May of each year, the City Clerk shall file an annual report with the City Council, compiling the information filed by lobbyists who reregister before April 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.” This year April 1<sup>st</sup> fell on Sunday, so the deadline laid over until the next business day, which was April 2, 2019.

All reports and statements filed with the City Clerk under this chapter shall be preserved by the City Clerk for a period of five years from the date of filing. Such reports and statements shall constitute part of the public records of the clerk’s office and shall be open to public inspection.”

The City Council of the City of Carson is authorized to regulate activities of persons and groups of persons who are hired or contracted for the purpose of lobbying or otherwise influencing municipal legislation.

The Lobbyist Registration Statements are available on the City Clerk's web page and in the Office of the City Clerk for public inspection.
