City of Carson reserve revenue: \$65,597,747.64

City of Carson cash revenue: \$8,774,143.40

City of Carson Successor Agency reserve revenue: \$10,249,552.80

City of Carson Successor Agency cash revenue: \$6,114,878.54

City of Carson Housing Authority cash revenue: \$2,037,998.94

City of Carson Housing Authority bond fund reserves \$3,124,287.17
