#### SUBJECT:

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 20-2016: AMENDING CARSON MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3311** (CITY COUNCIL)

#### I. SUMMARY

On October 6, 2020 under Item No. 39 of Council Agenda, City Council voted unanimously (JH/CH: 5/0) to introduce Ordinance No. 20-2016.

#### **II. RECOMMENDATION**

CONDUCT a Second Reading and ADOPT Ordinance No. 20-2016, "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 3311 OF THE CARSON MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCREASE THE FINE AMOUNTS APPLICABLE TO INFRACTIONS FOR VIOLATIONS OF CARSON MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3311 RELATED TO PREVENTION OF DOG EXCRETA NUISANCES."
