I. <u>SUMMARY</u>

When vacancies occur, they present staff with the ideal time to enhance job specs to reflect current needs based upon industry trends, community needs, technological advancements and business evolution. At this time, staff is presenting the updated Recreation Permits Coordinator job spec, which is a job series role with a title change to Recreation Reservations Coordinator to reflect current needs in the Community Services Department, Parks & Recreation Division.

This vacancy exists as a result of an employee retirement in the Division. The Community Services Department, Parks & Recreation Division is responsible for providing meaningful environmental, recreational and social experiences; providing positive recreational opportunities and experiences that will serve the diverse needs and interests of the community; and providing opportunities that will promote mental awareness, physical fitness, personal and social development. Staff completed the Meet & Confer with AFSCME 809 on October 7, 2021 and both parties are in agreement on the proposed Recreation Reservations Coordinator job series job specs.
