The Public Safety Division is responsible for developing and administering programs designed to enhance public safety and crime prevention by providing oversight of the City's law enforcement program and directing the City's Code Enforcement and Parking Enforcement Detail in the enforcement of the Municipal Code/City Charter and all City Ordinances. Staff completed the Meet & Confer with AME on November 16, 2021 and both parties are in agreement on the proposed Public Safety Services Manager job spec.
