CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION NO. 21-109, AMENDING THE CLASSIFICATION PLAN, RESOLUTION NO. 77-111, BY ADOPTING AMENDED JOB CLASSIFICATION SPECIFICATION FOR PURCHASING MANAGER (CITY COUNCIL)
